**Snow Removal**

**Winter Snow Removal Operations and Regulations**



The Dillon Public Works Department makes every effort possible to make winter travel in the Town of Dillon both easy and safe. Our crews can only accomplish this with your patience and cooperation. We would like to take this opportunity to familiarize you with our snow removal operations and regulations so that we may continue to provide you with the safest roads possible.

The Town is divided into snow removal routes. Snow removal routes are separated into primary and secondary routes. Primary routes include the Dillon Town Center, Town-owned streets in Dillon Ridge Marketplace, Lake Dillon Drive, and the Summit Stage bus route. Secondary routes are cleared immediately following primary routes and include Tenderfoot Street, LaBonte Street, East and West Buffalo, Three Rivers, East and West Anemone, Little Dam Street, Lodgepole Street, Gold Run, Corinthian Hills, Elkhorn and Oro Grande.

Public Works Staff is scheduled regularly seven days a week from 4 a.m. until 6 p.m. On-call personnel cover operations from 6 p.m. until 4 a.m. the following morning. Normal snow removal operations begin at 4 a.m. and continue as conditions warrant. During heavy snow events, crews work around the clock concentrating primarily on streets and sidewalks. Parking lots are only cleared during the 4 a.m. shift when lots are vacant, and generally are not plowed during business hours for that reason.

Parking regulations are strictly enforced throughout the Town to allow crews to clear snow. Please take the time to familiarize yourself with these regulations to prevent having your vehicle towed. Overnight parking is allowed only in designated lots in the Town Center, these lots are clearly indicated by blue and green signs. Overnight parking is permitted in blue lots on Mon., Wed., Fri. and in green lots on Tue., Thu., Sat., & Sun. Overnight parking is allowed in the Marina Park parking lot all week. Additionally, parking is not permitted from 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. on any Town street right-of-way.

Snow left in driveways during removal operations is a nuisance to most residents, but crews do not have the time to clean every driveway and make every effort to minimize the amount of snow left in driveways. Removal of snow from driveways is the responsibility of home owners and all snow must be stored on-site. The unpaved portion of the street right-of-way is used by the Town to store snow from the street, pushing snow from drives across the street or into the right-of-way is not permitted.



Your cooperation during the winter months allows crew to work efficiently and effectively to make our streets safe for everyone. Remember that Summit County has harsh weather conditions and drivers must use caution at all times. Always use caution around snow removal equipment and keep a safe distance back from sanding trucks. Avoid driving during poor weather conditions, make sure you have adequate snow tires and chains, always clear your vehicles windows of snow and ice, wear your seatbelt, and please slow down!
